

Figure 1. Providers reporting they “agree” or “strongly agree” that they are confident they have the skills for care of suicidal ED patients, by provider type and study phase.

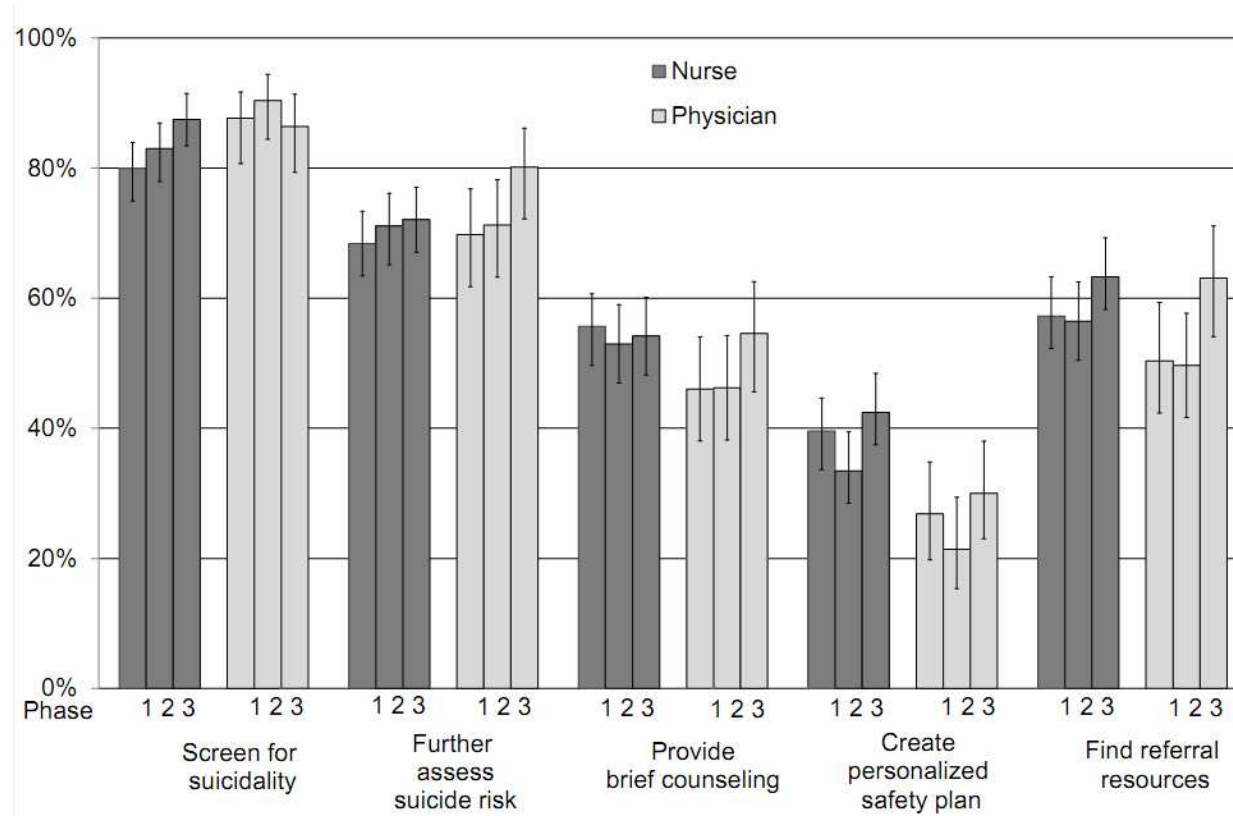


Figure 1 Legend. Bars represent 95% Confidence Intervals.

Figure 2. Providers' attitudes concerning care of suicidal ED patients, by provider type and study phase.

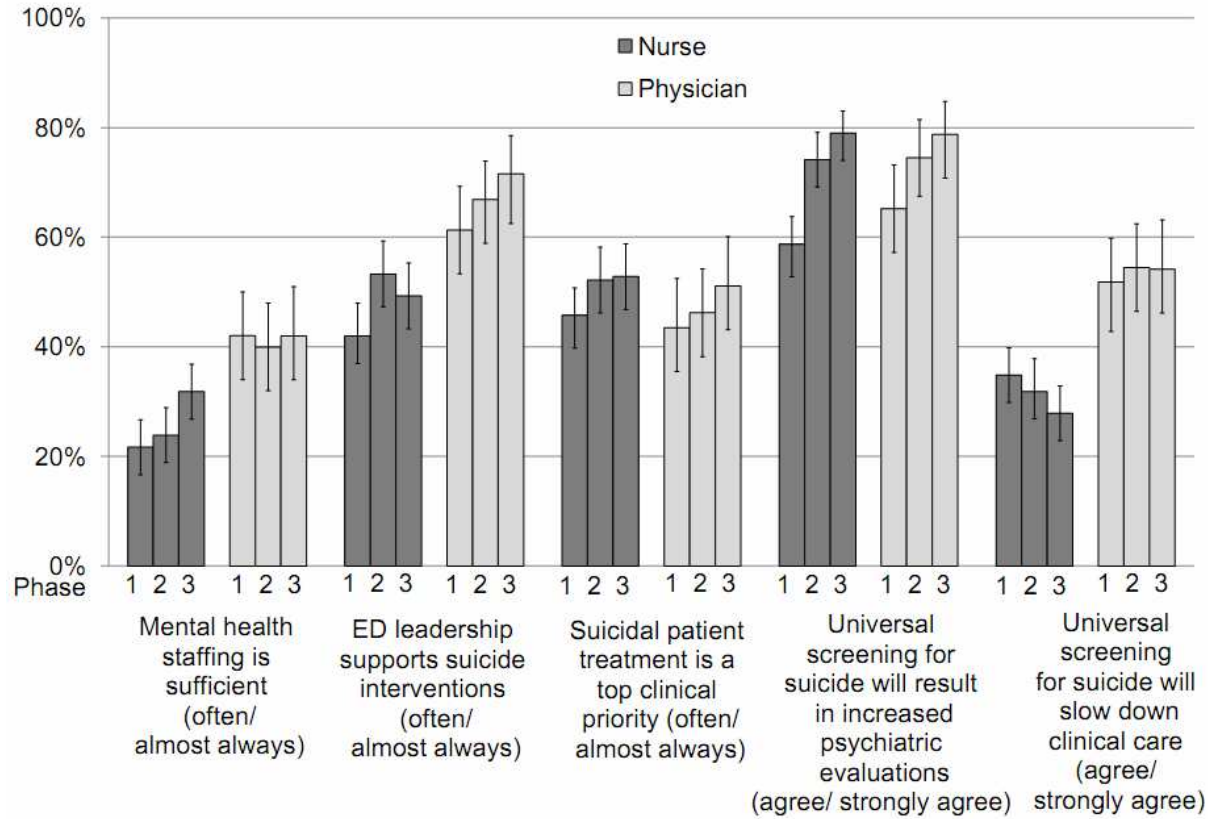


Figure 2 Legend. Bars represent 95% Confidence Intervals.

Figure 3. Proportion of providers who report “often” or “almost always” providing additional assessment or care to most or all suicidal patients, by provider type and study phase.

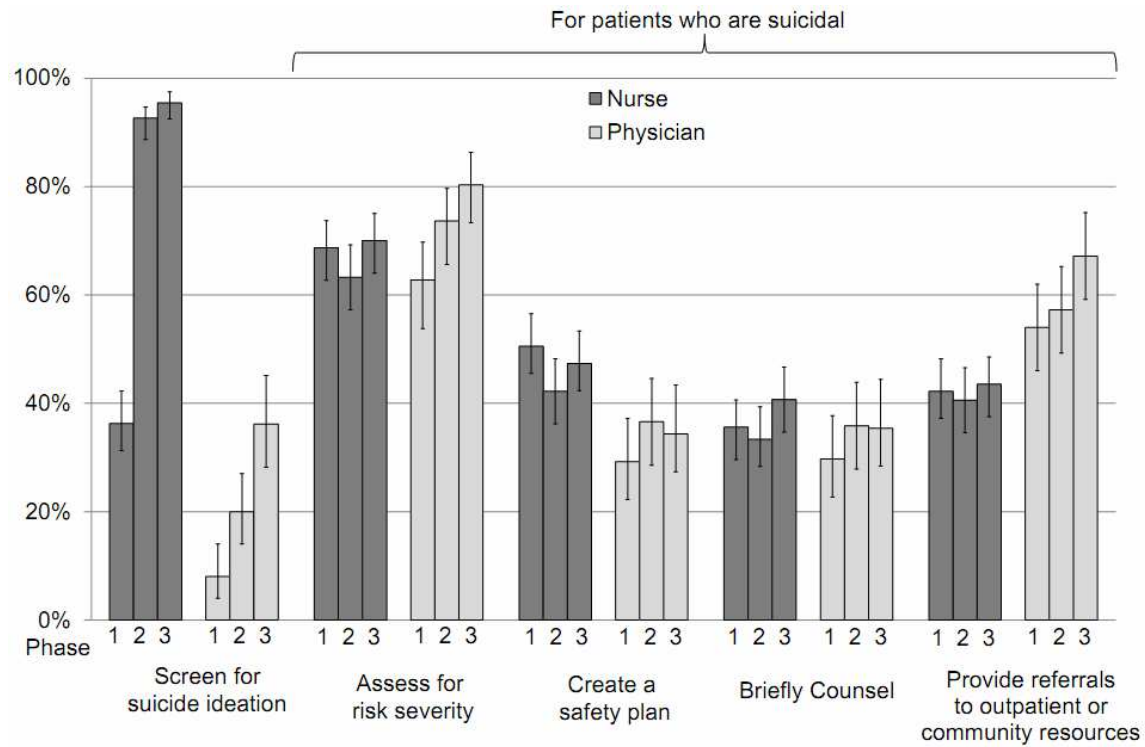


Figure 3 Legend. Bars represent 95% Confidence Intervals.

Figure 4. Providers reporting “often” or “almost always” asking suicidal patients if there are firearms at home for various patient scenarios, by provider type and study phase.

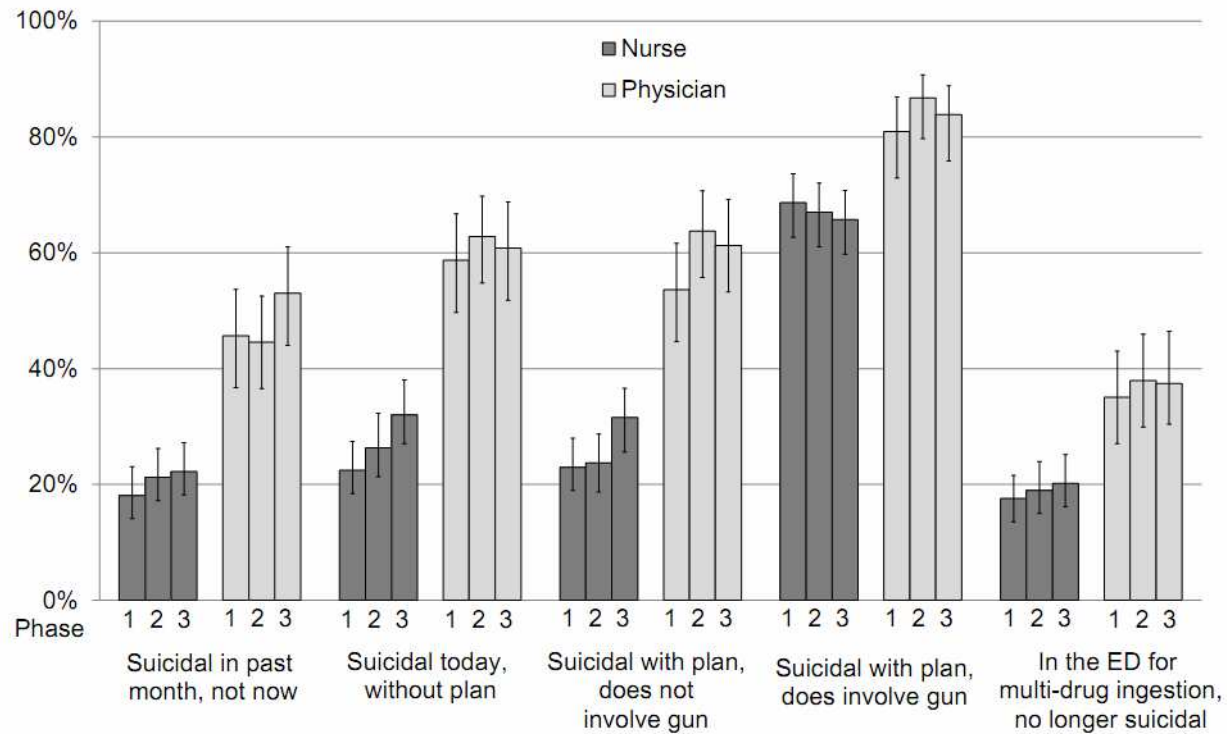


Figure 4 Legend. Bars represent 95% Confidence Intervals.
