

SUPPLEMENTAL TABLE 1. Examples of medications discussed among cost conversations^a

Class of Medications	Medications Discussed
Selective serotonin reuptake inhibitors	citalopram (Celexa), escitalopram (Lexapro), fluoxetine (Prozac), paroxetine (Paxil, Pexeva), sertraline (Zoloft)
Serotonin-norepinephrine reuptake inhibitors	desvenlafaxine (Pristiq), duloxetine (Cymbalta), venlafaxine (Effexor)
Other anti-depressants	bupropion (Wellbutrin, Aplenzin), desipramine (Norpramin), mirtazapine (Remeron), vilazodone (Viibryd)
Mood stabilizers	lithium (Lithobid, Eskalith), zonisamide (Zonegran [used as a mood stabilizer])
Antipsychotics	aripiprazole (Abilify), iloperidone (Fanapt), lurasidone (Latuda), quetiapine (Seroquel), risperidone (Risperdal)
Benzodiazepines, sleep aids and other anxiolytics	alprazolam (Xanax), amitriptyline (Elavil [used as sleep aid]), buspirone (BuSpar), clonazepam (Klonopin), diazepam (Valium), estazolam (ProSom), eszopiclone (Lunesta), flurazepam (Dalmane), hydroxyzine (Atarax, Vistaril), melatonin, trazodone (Desyrel [used as sleep aid]), triazolam (Halcion), zolpidem (Ambien, Edular)
Stimulants and ADHD^b medications	amphetamine salts (Adderall), armodafinil (Nuvigil), atomoxetine (Strattera), dexamethylphenidate (Focalin), lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse), methylphenidate (Ritalin, Concerta), modafinil (Provigil)
Other psychotropics	acamprosate (Campral), buprenorphine/naloxone (Suboxone), dextromethorphan/quinidine (Nuedexta), fluoxetine/olanzapine combination (Symbyax), l-methylfolate (Deplin), thyroid supplements as depression augmentation
Non-psychotropics	adalimumab (Humira), esomeprazole (Nexium), hyoscyamine (Levsin), lansoprazole (Prevacid), leuprolide (Lupron), niacin (Niaspan, Niacor), nicotine patch (Nicoderm), omeprazole (Prilosec), sulphur skin gel (Prosacea); non-specific examples included anti-inflammatory patch, hepatitis C medications, multivitamins and pain medications
