 A **red triangle** indicates this patient is in the top 0.1% risk group for the facility in the current month.
 A **yellow triangle** indicates he/she was in the top 0.1% in the past.
 Click on the triangle to go to the patient's REACH Vet report.

Patient Record Flag

This column indicates whether a patient has/had an active Patient Record Flag for High Risk of Suicide.
 A **red diamond** indicates the flag is currently active.
 The **light orange diamond** indicates the flag was active at the time of discharge, but has since been discontinued.

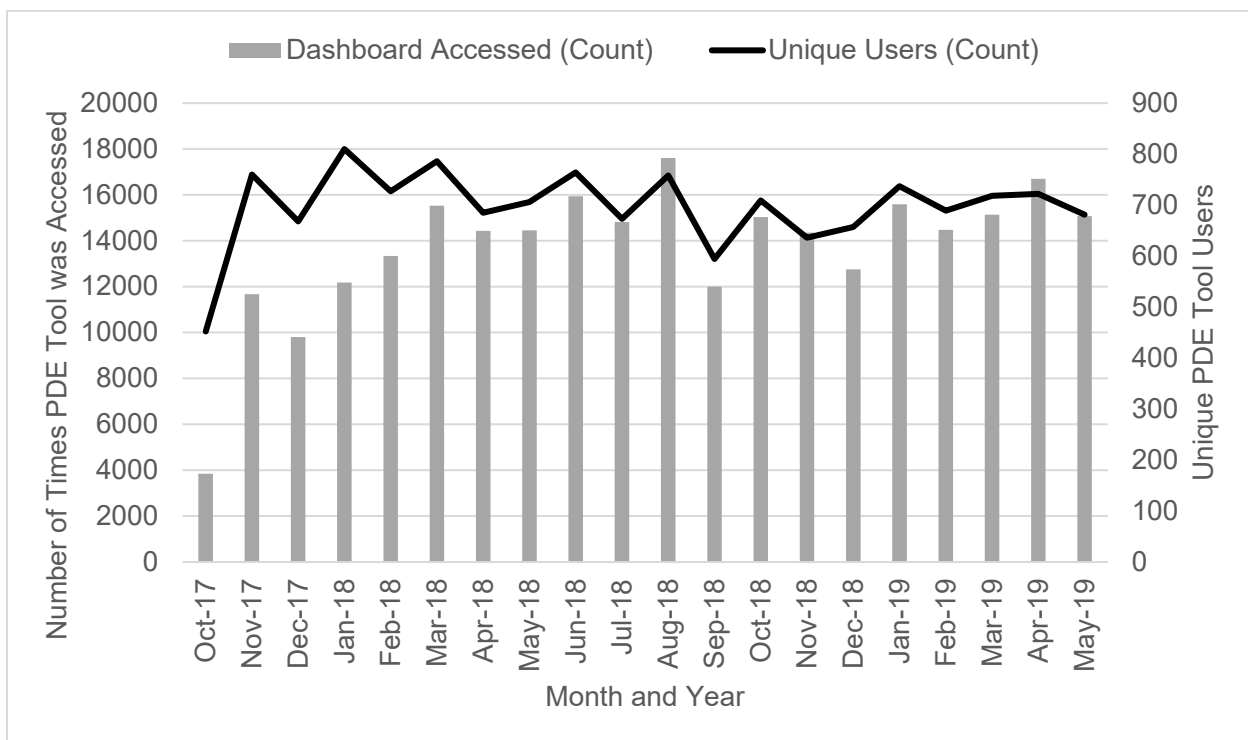

Data on Use of PDE Population Management Tool Since Launch

This section highlights use of the PDE population management tool since its launch.

The PDE population management tool to support population management was adopted quickly at VHA after activating the PDE measure (next **Figure**). The tool was fully functional by January 2018, a month during which 810 unique users accessed the tool 12,176 times. Since January 2018, 708 unique users opened the tool 14,669 times per month, on average. Users accessed the report at a rate of 20.7 times per month, on average, or approximately once per business day.
