| Patients with a positive PHQ-9/GAD-7 and 2+ visits with a behavioral health provider at primary care clinic. Excluded everyone who was ever engaged in the collaborative care model (ever engaged N = 5,247).

¶ Improvement is defined by a 50% decrease from baseline score or a score less than 10 on the PHQ-9 and/or GAD-7 at 10-14 week follow-up (used motified intent-to-treat analysis). Patient scored positive on either or both scales at baseline.
