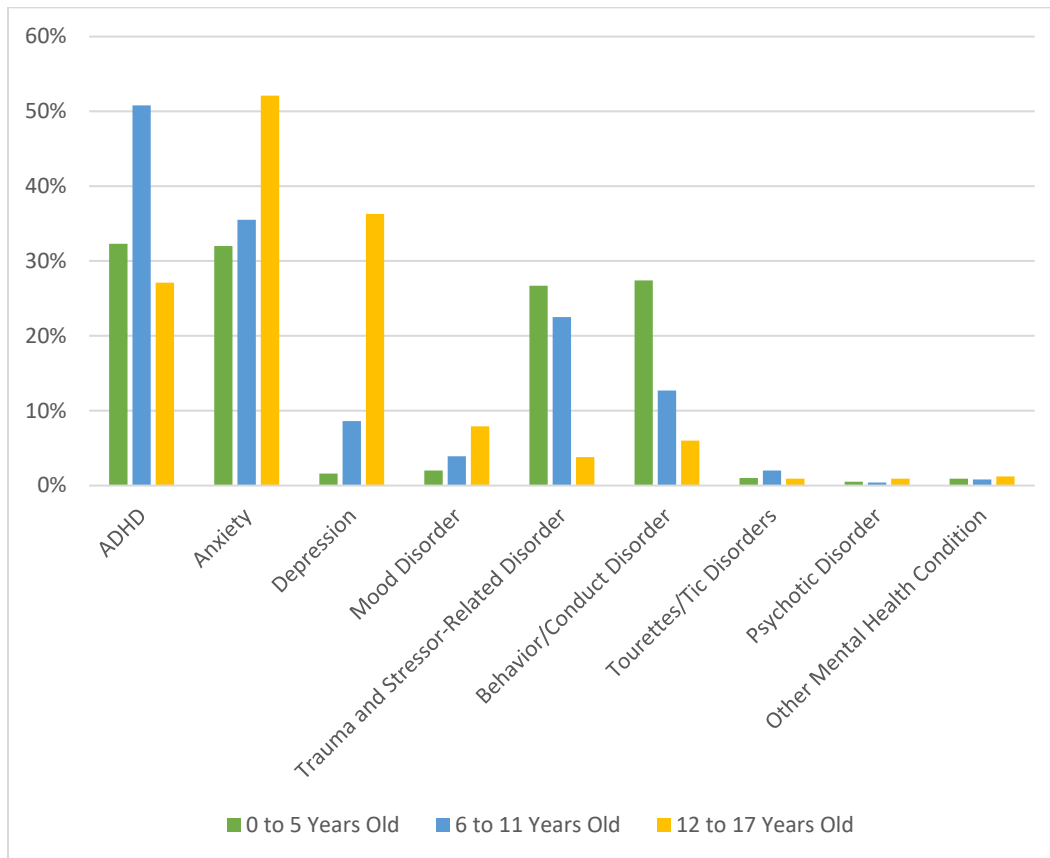


For this analysis, data from December 2018 through April 2021 were drawn from IQVIA US Open Source Claims, a multi-payer (Medicaid, Medicare and private insurance, including employer-sponsored and individual market), patient linked database consisting of professional claims generated by office-based physicians (CMS-1500), institutional claims generated by hospitals and other institutions (UB-04), and longitudinal prescription (LRx) claims. The database covers over 180 million patients from all 50 states and Washington, D.C.
