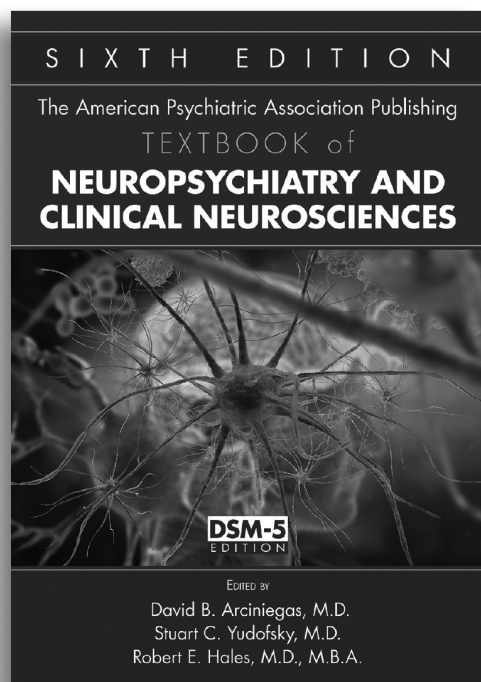

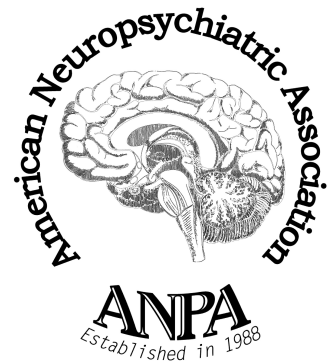


American Neuropsychiatric Association

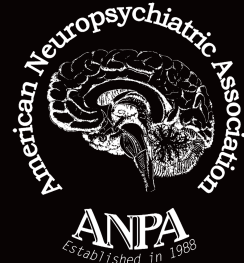
