Prevalence of ADHD Among Racial-Ethnic Groups in a Public Mental Health System

Although national studies have reported higher ADHD rates for white children than for children from other racial-ethnic groups, this study of children in New York State's public mental health system found lower rates for white children in nearly all age and gender groups.

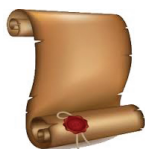
Perception of Coercion Among Patients With a Community Treatment Order: A Review

Patients with a community treatment order (CTO) are more likely to feel coerced than voluntary patients, according to a literature review of 23 articles. But there are ways to mitigate perceived coercion, such as educating patients about the legal processes governing CTOs in their jurisdiction.

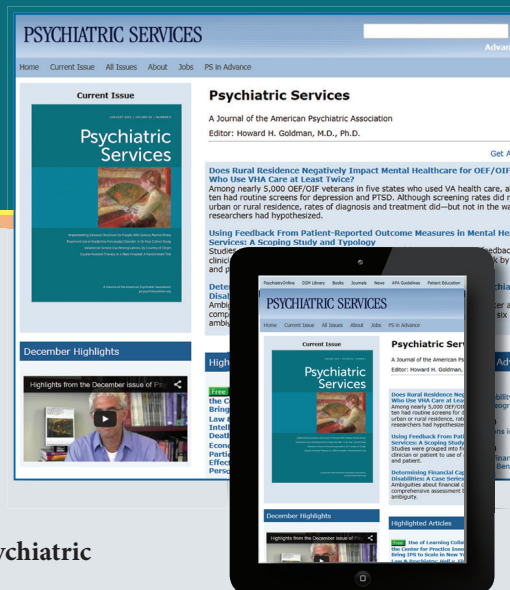
